Housing will be provided for participants from Saturday, May 26 to Wednesday, June 27 (check-out). Regular check-in for the program is scheduled between 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturday, May 26. Only pre-arranged late arrivals (until 1:00 a.m.) can be accommodated. St. Andrew's Hall charges a \$10 fee per person for arrivals after 10 p.m. to be paid upon arrival. Check-out is by 10 a.m. on Wednesday, June 27, unless pre-arranged.
