





## SCALE 2018 – 2019 Curriculum

**Pre-Period 1** (Prior to the start of classes; students will be sent Early Start Modules on the following topics: General Introduction to Law School; Time-Management; Reading and Briefing Cases; and Note-taking.)

## SCALE I

Period 1 June 18, 2018 – August 31, 2018 (10 units; 11 weeks)

- Academic Skills Lab I All students will watch designated modules and attend inclass workshops designed to reinforce the instruction received. Topics covered will include: weekly review, outlining, exam-writing, and multiple-choice strategies.

## SCALE II

**Period 5** August 6, 2018 – October 12, 2018 (8 or 10 units; 10 weeks)

- Constitutional Law I (3 units)
- Community Property (2 units)
- Cal Bar Writing: Skills and Strategies (3 units)
- Legislation (2 units) OR students may choose Traditional Fall Elective over Period 5 and 6 (2-3 units earned in Period 6)

Period 6 October 15, 2018 – December 21, 2018 (minimum 8 units, possibly 10 or 12; 10 weeks)

- Constitutional Law II (3 units)
- o Business Associations (4 units)
- MBE Course (1 unit)
- Required Traditional Fall in lieu of Legislation (2 units)
- Additional Required Traditional Fall Elective (2 units) (students may choose a traditional Spring, if they prefer)

Period 7 December 31, 2018 – March 8, 2019 (10 units; 10 weeks)

- Representing Entrepreneurs (3 units) *OR* Traditional Spring Elective over Period 7 and 8 (2-3 units)
- MBE Course (1 unit)
- Wills and Trusts (4 units)
- Intersession (2 units)\* (If needed to meet 87 unit requirement)
- *Required Spring Elective* (2-3 units) [for students who did not take required Fall Elective]

Period 8 March 11, 2019 – May 17, 2019 (8-12 units; 10 weeks)

- Mandatory Period 8 Externship (5 units)
- MBE Course (1 unit)

- Trial Advocacy (2 units) *OR Spring Elective* (2-3 units)
- Required Spring Traditional Elective, if chosen instead of Required Fall Traditional Elective (2-3 units)

\*All students must have 87 units to graduate and will need to make decisions concerning the number of units of Traditional Electives and Intersession choices with this in mind.
