



# SCALE 2018 – 2019 2.5-Year Curriculum

**Pre-Period 1** (Prior to the start of classes; students will be sent Early Start Modules on the following topics: General Introduction to Law School; Time-Management; Reading and Briefing Cases; and Note-taking.)

## **Period 1** June 18, 2018 – August 31, 2018 (10 units; 11 weeks)

- Academic Skills Lab I All students will watch designated modules and attend inclass workshops designed to reinforce the instruction received. Topics covered will include: weekly review, outlining, exam-writing, and multiple-choice strategies.

- Additional Required Traditional Fall Elective (2 units) (students may choose traditional Spring, if they prefer)

**Period 7** December 31, 2018 – March 8, 2019 (5-7 units; 10 weeks)

- o Intersession (1-2 units)\* (If needed to meet 87 unit requirement)
