CALIFORNIA STATE SUPERIOR COURTS
State Court

In order to practice in the State of California and appear in the California State Superior Court, you must be admitted to the Bar of the State of California. Admission into the Bar of the State of California is required.

ADMISSION FEE

No current fees are due at the time of the swearing-in ceremony. State bar fees will be billed to you directly after the swearing-in ceremony.

MEMBER ENROLLMENT CARD

Please bring member enrollment card (5x7 white card) issued by the California State Bar which will be included in the packet that all bar passers will receive from the State Bar. Southwestern does not provide these forms. If you are missing the enrollment card please contact the California State Bar Office of Admissions at (213) 765-1550. You cannot be sworn if this card is not submitted to Southwestern before the swearing-in ceremony.

COMPLETING THE CARD

1. Front Side of Enrollment Card

- Must be completed and must include *at least* the participant's name, date of birth, and address.
- Please note, information provided on this form will be made public on the California State Bar Website (www.calbar.ca.gov)
- If you wish to keep your resident information private, we suggest using a post office box. Address information must be completed as this is the address the California State Bar will send your bar fee information and bar card.

2. Back Side of Enrollment Card

- Sign in the space provided for "Member's Signature"
- Date the card with the date of the ceremony, **June 3, 2019**

CERTIFICATES

The California State Bar will mail certificates directly to each individual. Fees for the certificates will be billed directly from the California State Bar along with your Annual Membership fees after the swearing-in ceremony.

BAR CARDS

Bar cards will be automatically mailed to the attorney's address of record (provided on your member enrollment card) following payment of Annual Membership fees.
