Bertrall Ross is the Chancellor's Professor of Law at U.C. Berkeley School of Law. His research is driven by a concern about democratic responsiveness and accountability, as well as the inclusion of marginalized communities in the political process. Bertrall's past scholarship in the areas of election law, constitutional law, and statutory interpretation has been published in the Columbia Law Review, NYU Law Review, and the University of Chicago Law Review, among others. Bertrall earned his J.D. from Yale Law School and Masters degrees from the London School of Economics and Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs. Prior to joining Berkeley Law, he was a Kellis Parker Academic Fellow at Columbia Law School.
