## **Video and Audio Taping of Class Policy**

Administrative policy approved July 22, 2022. Effective immediately.

**Scheduled Review Date: June 2023 (Information Technology Office; Vice Dean's Office)** 

During Fall 2022, virtually all class sessions will be recorded because of the presence of remote learners. Under non-pandemic circumstances, professors have discretion whether to permit a class to be video or audio taped upon a student's request. Students are not permitted to record by any video or audio means any law school class before receiving permission from the professor or the Dean of Students. If a student audiotapes a class, the student, upon request, should be willing to share the recording with other students. Absent compelling reasons, videotapes of classes will be made available to all students enrolled in the class.

In accordance with the above policy, all students should be aware that any class, and discussions held during class, shortly before, shortly after class, and during recorded or livestreamed events may be subject to recording.
